Cultivating a Distinctively Christian Imagination

First Memphis Family,

A few weeks ago, I quoted Lanta Davis' article on the Christian imagination. Davis argues that the contemporary church is suffering from a lack of

imagination, and warns, "the imagination is not starving itself. It's simply finding its food elsewhere." She continues, "If we don't cultivate a distinctively Christian imagination... we risk consuming alternative imaginations in its stead."

In these next few months, you will be hearing a lot about Godly Play. Godly Play is a Montessori based children's curriculum that both tells the stories of scripture and teaches the rhythms of the church in a way that inspires the imagination and invites wonder.

We will introduce you to this way of learning and invite you to discover anew the stories of God with us. It is my hope that First Memphis will invest in building the Christian imaginations of our children, and our own, through this program. In the meantime, I will leave you with one set of wondering questions considered after a story is told in the Godly Play classroom:

- 1. I wonder what part you liked best.
- 2. I wonder what part is most important.
- 3. I wonder where you find yourself in this story, or what part of this story is about you.
- 4. I wonder what part we could leave out and still have all the story we need.

Perhaps these questions will help us all dive a little deeper into our own readings of scripture.

Ash Wednesday Service


MARCH 2, SANCTUARY, 6:15 PM
